If you need assistance in taking advantage of the following benefits, please contact the service coordinator at 241-1457. She can explain the programs and give you details and eligibility criteria about them. She can assist you in applying or recertifying for the benefit by providing the necessary applications and sending them to the providers or by setting up an appointment with the provider.

The Lifeline Credit Program for telephone services allows you to choose between a free cell phone with 250 free minutes every month or a discount off of your land line telephone bill each month.

FREE amplified telephone and telephones that type what is being said on the other end of the line are available for those who are hard of hearing or have a hearing impairment. There is a selection of different types of phones available through Florida Telecommunications Relay, Inc.

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program will have funding available in July to assist with the cost of your electric bill. If you have received this benefit before, there is a 13 month and one day waiting period before you can receive it again. The Gail Baker Center in Donner Park in the Mayport area offers program enrollment and Dial-A-Ride is available for transport.


