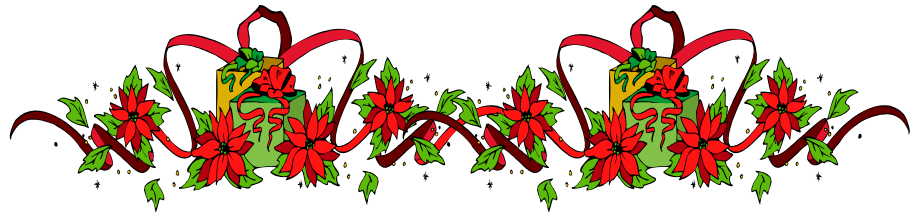
### HAPPY HOLIDAYS
