Shirley claims her crowning achievement is her daughter, and feels blessed by having a daughter like Debbie.

Shirley loves telling stories (Southerners always have stories) about her life as a pure-bred southerner. And she make no excuses for her "downhome" lifestyle. As someone once said, "I was country before it was cool to be country". That's Shirley.
