#### **HAPPY 4TH OF JULY**

Here are some interesting facts about our important holiday:

- Initially adopted by Congress on July 2, 1776, the revised version of the Declaration of Independence was not adopted until two days later.
- The oldest, continuous Independence Day celebration in the U.S. is the 4th of July parade in Bristol, Rhode Island; it began in 1785.
- Three U.S. Presidents—John Adams, Thomas Jefferson and James Monroe—died on July 4th; Adams and Jefferson died within hours of each other in 1826 while Monroe died in 1831.
- France, Greece, Poland, Russia and several countries in South America used the Declaration of Independence as a beacon in their own struggles for freedom
- Americans consume about 155 million hot dogs on Independence Day alone; it is the biggest hot dog holiday of the year!

#### **HURRICANE SEASON NEWS!**

If the Mayor orders a mandatory evacuation of the beaches area, there will be no exceptions to this order. All residents will need to leave the property. There will be no power, meaning no air conditioning, no lighting, no working elevators, no electricity to power oxygen tanks, scooters, wheelchairs, CPAP and BiPAP machines, or nebulizer machines. Emergency personnel will be evacuating for three days so there will be no assistance available.

If you have not turned in your Disaster Preparedness Form to the Service Coordinator yet, please do so as soon as possible. Management needs this form to account for your whereabouts if evacuation is necessary. You may want to put your beaches re-entry pass in your emergency evacuation kit for safe keeping. Also, you should be prepared for power outages at anytime during this season. Please be sure to have a flashlight and fresh batteries on hand.
