Patsy Graddick—I really don't know very much about her as I haven't really had much opportunity to sit and chat with her. But from what I do know, I can tell you she has led a very interesting life. I envy her getting to be a flight attendant; it was a dream of mine that never materialized.

Patsy Martin was born on March 23, 1942, in Coffee County, AL to Bill and Mammie Martin. She has one sister. Patsy graduated from Vigor High School in Mobile, AL. After graduation she started working at Merchants National Bank, during which time she met Jesse Graddick, Jr.

They married in 1965 and had two beautiful children—a daughter Joy and a son, Michael. Joy lives here in Jacksonville and Michael passed away in 2004.

Patsy's husband's job took them several places to live, among them St. David, Bermuda. In 1980, they moved to Park City, Utah where she worked for the United States Olympic Ski Team. One year while helping organize the Celebrity Ski Classic, she worked in tandem with Alan and Donny Osmond. She

found them as sweet and down to earth as their reported reputation. After that she worked with the corporate offices of Mrs. Fields Cookies during their initial start-up.

In 1985 Patsy and Jesse decided to go their own separate ways. Being a single woman with grown children, she decided to start to work with Continental Airlines. She says being a flight attendant was the best job she ever had. After only one year with them, she became Flight Service Manager until the program was eliminated in 1996. Patsy was then transferred to the International Department and worked there until she retired in 2005. She had the pleasure of getting to travel all of Europe, parts of the Middle East, Japan and Hong Kong.

Patsy was in the air returning to Newark, NJ from Milan, Italy on 9/11/2001 when the attack on the Twin Towers happened. They were half way there when the Captain told them what had happened and that they would be diverted to Gander, Newfoundland. They were not allowed to tell the passengers though until they landed in Newfoundland.

They had to spend five days there, but found the towns people to be very friendly and generous. They took the passengers and housed them in homes, churches and schools. The crew was taken to a hotel about 30 miles from Gander. As Patsy had the only working cell phone, everyone used her phone, including a reporter from CBS news who did remote reporting. When they left and started their landing pattern at Newark, the plane became very quiet and as they looked over New York City, they could still see huge plumes of smoke rising out of the tower ruins.

Patsy moved into Pablo Towers in 2012. If you get a chance to talk to her, she can give you more details about 9-11 than I can in this limited space.
