## RESIDENT OF THE MONTH Alan Kerr

Alan Kerr was born in London, England of Jewish parents in 1928. Alan is an accomplished violinist and also has made violins. In fact, the violin he is currently playing is the first one he made. At a young age he learned to read music; first he learned to play the piano and then the violin. And today at 87 years of age, he is still playing the violin beautifully.

In 1939 when Alan was just 12 years old, World War II began. When the Battle of Britton began, he was evacuated five times. It seemed every place they sent him was being bombed. In Devon he saw a fight between a U -boat and a submarine chaser. In Wales they dropped a landmine a quarter of a mile from the largest coal mine in the country. When he eventually got to go back to London, it was just in time for the bombing of London. In 1954 Alan left England for America. It was in Jacksonville, FL he learned tailoring, thus becoming a very accomplished tailor. He yearned to travel, which he did as his career as a tailor allowed him to do. He went to Miami twice, Los Angeles four times, then returned to Jacksonville.

It was in Jacksonville where he met Floranna who was to become his wife of 26 years. The last six years of her life she had Parkinson's. When she passed away, Alan came here to Pablo Towers.

Such a rich history and blessed life. We are happy that he survived the war and brought his talents and skills to America. Alan tells me he has many more stories. Unfortunately our space is limited. He said he could write a book of his experiences, and I wholeheartedly encourage him to do so.
