RESIDENT OF THE MONTH—LUCY HALE

Lucy was born in Ceiba, Puerto Rico which is a US territory. Therefore, babies become American's at birth. Her parents moved to Philadelphia first, then Lucy, her brother and little sister came later. Lucy was eight years old when she came to live with her parents. Like most children not born in the continental US, they view America by what they hear and see on television. So needless to say, Lucy was disappointed that there were no cowboys and Indians in Philadelphia, plus it was cold . . . not anything like the island she spent her first eight years on. Lucy and her little sister went directly to school, unlike her brother who went to learn English first. How difficult!


GRANDPARENTS GETTING WIRED COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
