This is the time to make changes to your Medicare Advantage Plan or Medicare Prescription Drug coverage for 2019. It is wise to find out if your current plan will continue to serve you well and be the most cost-effective plan for 2019.

TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE WITH RESEARCHING THIS, YOU CAN:

- Call Medicare at 1-800-MEDICARE and give the representative the names of your prescription drugs.
- Call the ElderSource Helpline at 904-391-6699 and request a SHINE Counselor assist you.
- Call Amerilife Direct Medicare Referral at 855-783-0001 and use NPN #548310 and give the representative the names of your prescriptions.
- If you are already a client of Insurance Broker Karen Ansell, you can call 904-242-8893, and she or someone on her team can assist you.
