SHINE offers seniors, adults with disabilities and their caregivers free, unbiased counseling on Medicare and health insurance issues. SHINE's goal is to help you find the information and resources you need to make the best decisions about your health insurance coverage. Counselors and volunteers are not affiliated with any insurance company and will not attempt to sell health insurance to you.

SHINE can: • Help you understand your Medicare benefits. • Help you determine which Medicare Prescription Drug Plan best fits your needs. • Answer questions about Medigap and other health insurance programs. • Help you determine if you qualify for benefits that you

save money such as: • Monthly Part D drug plan premiums • Co-pays for prescriptions • Monthly Medicare Part B premiums • Co-pays for Medicare services and visits • Medicare deductibles
