ENJOYING YOUR JACKSONVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY EVENTS, CLASSES AND OPPORTUNITIES WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12th at 2:30 P.M.

Start Here. Go Anywhere. We encourage you to plan to attend this very informational program about the services that are available through the Jacksonville library system in 2024. Tonja Ferrell, a library supervisor who heads the interlibrary and accessibility services, will tell us about the many opportunities and services that are available today. Did you know that you can get technology assistance virtually, join a book club or attend our Beaches branch library to take a yoga class? Have you heard of Hoopla, Kanopy or Flipster? These are all digital programs you can access through the library. You have the ability to listen to audiobooks, stream films, and look at magazines in your home. Now the Jacksonville Public Library is offering a new program called "Books by Mail". Tonja will explain the "Books by Mail" service and will assist anyone that is interested in signing up for "Books by Mail". Once you order a book, you can begin to receive your materials within a few days. While Tonja is here, she will assist any of you in signing up for your own library card if you do not already have a library card. Tonja will provide information about the Talking Books service for those with vision loss, answer any questions and provide applications for anyone who would like to sign up to receive Talking Books by mail. We hope you will attend!!!

HEARING HEALTH 101 FRIDAY, JUNE 14th at 2:30 P.M.

Do you have concerns about your hearing? When someone speaks to you, do you find that you have to ask them to repeat what they said? Have you had to turn up the volume on your television or your telephone? We encourage each of you to attend this

educational program presented by audiologist, Dr. Jane Burns. Dr. Burns will enlighten us about our amazing auditory system and hearing loss. Hearing loss has been linked with a variety of medical, social and cognitive concerns. A research study by Johns Hopkins University suggests that hearing loss may be a risk factor for dementia, and using a hearing aid during the early stages may even prevent some forms of dementia. Dr. Burns is passionate about helping people with hearing loss and faithfully, without charging for the visit, comes to Pablo Towers on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 2:00 to 4:00 P.M. Dr. Burns meets with any resident who has questions, concerns or needs the doctor to make adjustments on their hearing aids. Dr. Burns will talk about the difference hearing aids can make in a person's life and will tell you about the Lend An Ear Outreach Inc. nonprofit program which provides new hearing aids to seniors, no matter their income level.



Additionally, Dr. Burns will introduce us to Michael Mcquilkin, who is the North Florida account manager with CaptionCall. Michael will explain the benefits of using a captioned phone to be able to communicate clearly while talking on the phone. CaptionCall empowers hard-of-hearing individuals to make and receive phone calls with instant live captions. Michael will demonstrate how the phone works and how someone can apply for this free telephone.

Dr. Burns and Michael will provide refreshments for those who attend the program.
