HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS TOWN HALL

TUESDAY, JUNE 24th AT 2:30 P.M

We encourage you to attend this extremely important meeting! With thoughts of Hurricanes Matthew and Irma in the memories of many of us, NOW is the time to make your preparations for this year's hurricane season. We want to make every resident aware that in the event of an approaching Category 1 hurricane, the residents of the beaches are told that there is a mandatory evacuation of the beaches. That means that the residents of Pablo Towers need to evacuate, as well. Have you asked yourself, "What will I do if we must evacuate, because of an approaching hurricane?" In our effort to give you accurate information, the executive director of the Red Cross, Christian Smith, and our local fire marshal, Steve Sciotto, will educate us on what has been discussed during their 2025 planning sessions with our City of Jacksonville leaders. Ms. Smith will also explain how each of you should prepare to evacuate, as well as how to prepare if you plan to go to one of the shelters. We will also discuss what each of you need to do before leaving Pablo Towers and what the procedure is for returning. Refreshments will be provided.
